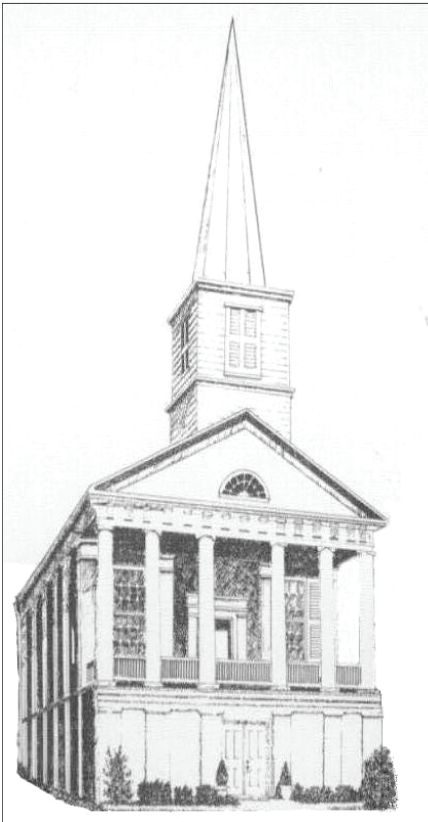

This is the mission/vision statement that our session has continued to work with over the last 8 months. It appears on every session docket, and ministry teams are challenged to keep it in front of them as they tend to their particular responsibilities.

The Stewardship Ministry Team has been using this statement with focused intention over the past several weeks. As we have thought about and planned stewardship season, we have talked at length about how Jonesborough Presbyterian Church helps us to know, love and serve God, and how important music, story and laughter are to us individually and to our identity as a congregation. We decided to use the last Sundays of August, September and October to emphasize stewardship.

We are deeply grateful to our young people who did such an inspiring job of leading worship on August 26. Seeing them at work, hearing them tell their stories, sharing their laughter and their infectious joy delighted us and enlivened us. The commitment we make to our young people begins at baptism and carries throughout their lives. What they, in turn, offer to their church is a reflection of the support, encouragement and love shown to them by parents, grandparents, Sunday school teachers, youth advisors, and folks who simply take the opportunity to show interest in and appreciation for them.

On September 30, the second of our stewardship Sundays, we will turn our attention to story. The stories that we will lift up are not the kind of stories that get told next door at the ISC. The stories we are interested in are the stories that get told around the coffee pot on Sunday mornings, around the tables at family lunch and as we stand in the shade of the sycamore trees in the parking lot. These are the stories of our lives, the joys and pains of being human and of being members of Jonesborough Presbyterian Church.

The last Sunday in October we will celebrate the many ways that music blesses and shapes our faith. We have a magnificent music ministry at JPC and our various choirs will help us to sing and ring our way toward responses of gratitude, generosity and hope.

Yes, on Consecration Sunday, November 11, we will ask all who will to make financial pledges to this congregation. But stewardship is about *far* more than money. It's about who we are and who we are becoming as followers of Jesus. It's about listening for the ways in which God speaks to us and calls us into specific ministries.

***You are gifted and called.* What gifts do you claim for ministry and how can Jonesborough Presbyterian help you to develop them and offer them to others? How can this church help you to be a good steward of who you are and who you are becoming in Christ?**

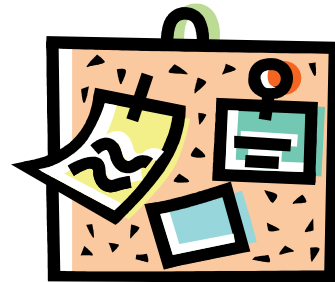


COME JOIN GENTLE YOGA!

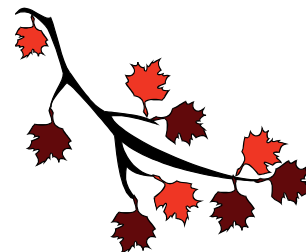
Gentle stretching & relaxation are the main focus of the class. ALL ARE WELCOME! For more information, you may call Carol at 788-3082. No previous experience is required!

FOR THOSE CONCERNED ABOUT SHARON SOERGEL

As most of you are aware, Ken & Jean Soergel’s granddaughter, Sharon, age 10, has been having a terrible issue with some type of condition that is rendering her unable to eat very few foods. Her father, Pete, said in a note:

“Sharon has a condition called RND (Reflex Neurovascular Dystrophy). That is a nerve condition almost like Gastric Reflux. This is called Eosinophilic Esophagitis. She has not been able to keep food down..”

Pete also mentioned that they have put Sharon on a diet similar to baby food formula. They think it will help heal the esophagus. She cannot eat ANY food —NONE—while on this formula.

Pete asks that we all keep her in our prayers. He says, “The power of the Lord Jesus will conquer all.”

Sharon loves drawing and artwork and has been advised by her doctor to keep doing her artwork and keeping her journals. The Soergels thank you for your concern and for your prayers.
